According to Pew Research Center, 1 in 4 people do not have broadband internet access in the home. Libraries provide access to the online world for those who need it.



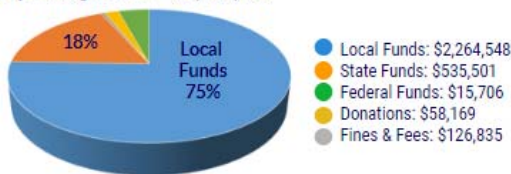

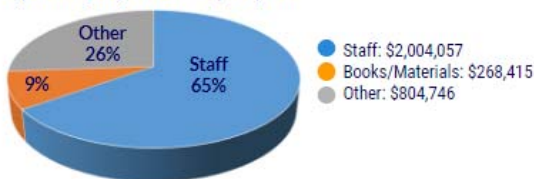
