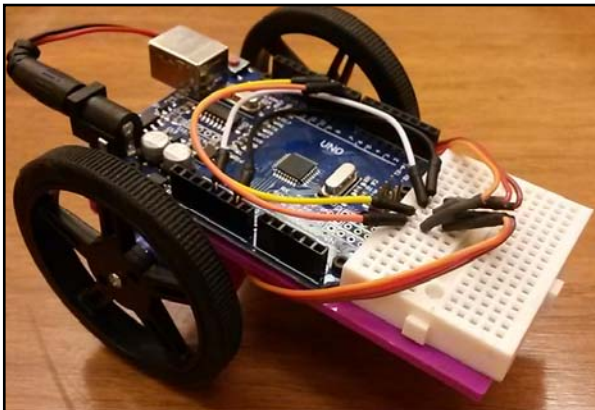


STEM @ Your Library

Robotics Series



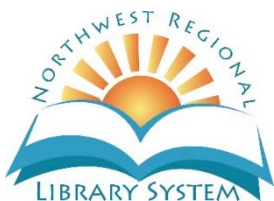
