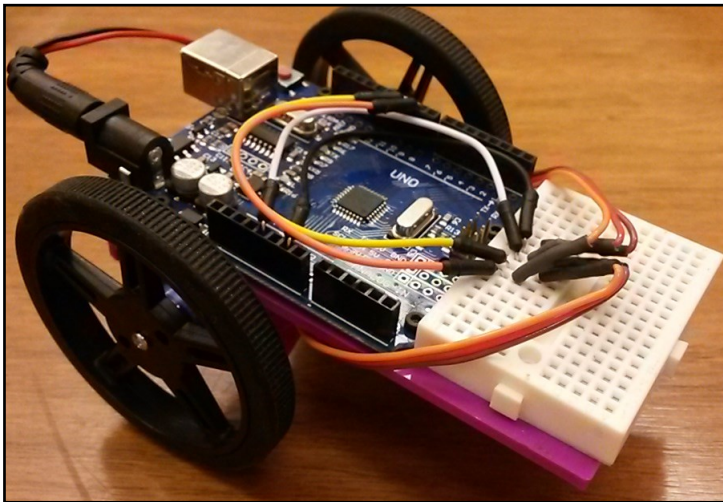


STEM @ Your Library
