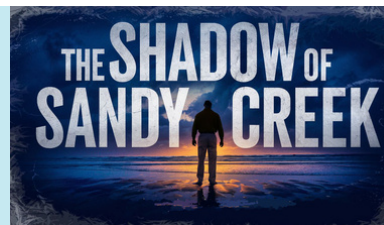

Tuesday, January 13 at 2 p.m. CT

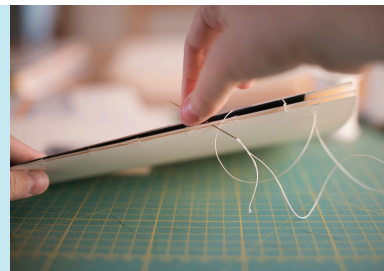
Join Kenny Redd of the Bay County Historical Society for an in-depth look at David Goodwin and the 1977 Sandy Creek Murders.

Tuesday, January 20 at 2 p.m. CT

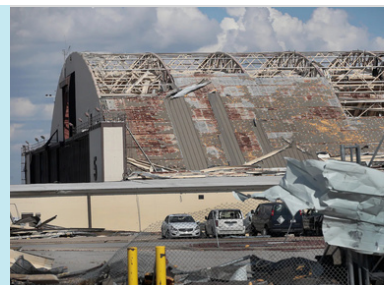
